Year 3 - Green

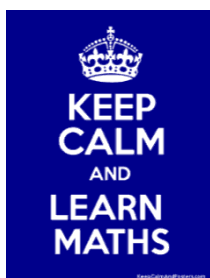
Year 4 - Blue
